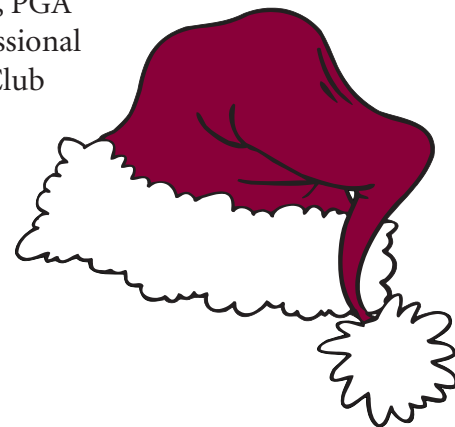
The golf shop is now stocked with apparel, hats, outerwear, gloves, and balls. Please stop by to check out the latest merchandise.

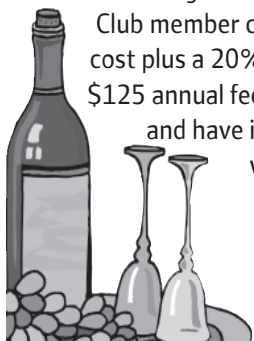
