Remember, children of all ages are welcome in the main dining room.



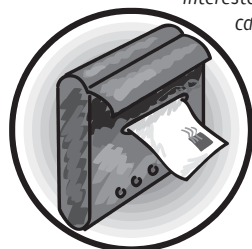

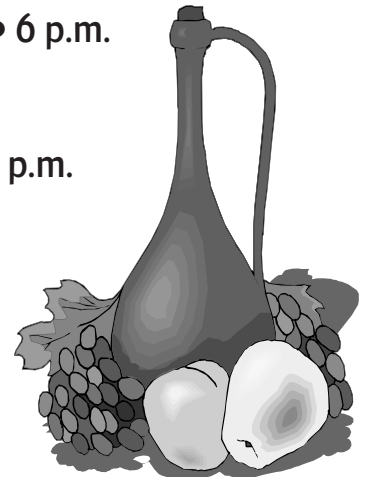
